## **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- All exhibitors must currently be enrolled and participating in the Coweta County 4-H program.
- 4-H members must qualify as “active” members of the Coweta County 4-H Livestock Club and fulfill all fair qualifications in order to show in the Coweta County 4-H Goat Show.
- Showmanship classes will be Pre-Club, Cloverleaf, Junior and Senior as determined by the 4-H’ers *grade* as of August 1, 2008.
- Conformation classes (doe and wether classes) will be established by the age and breed of the goats being shown.
- Entry forms must be turned into Renee Willis by Thursday, August 21, 2008 at a 4-H Livestock Club meeting or the Coweta County Extension Office.
- 4-H’ers are required to turn in their “Thank You Notes” to Renee Willis by Tuesday, September 23, 2008 in order to receive show prizes.

## **GENERAL RULES**

- All goats must check in and be inspected on Wednesday, September 17<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m.
- Only one goat per child, per class may be shown.
- All goats must be owned or maintained by the 4-H’er at least 90 days prior to the show, unless the goat(s) is less than 90 days old.
- Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in both showmanship and conformation classes.
- No bucks are allowed in the barn area.
- Animals must be removed after 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 25 or before 12:00 p.m. on Friday, September 26, 2008.
- Goats are shown at owner’s risk. Each exhibitor must assume liability in case of death or injury to his/her livestock.
- Decision of the judge(s) will be final.
- Any animal exhibiting vicious or uncontrollable aggression which endangers the safety of the judge, other exhibitors or another animal may be excused from the class.
- All fees for health papers are the 4-H’ers responsibility and must be kept in the Livestock Binder in the Ag Building that will be available for inspection.
